It was, yet again, voted unanimously by Linwood residents that we as a community do not support the Sunnybrook Extension into 3-Creeks in any way shape or form. There is no “compromise” that can make this road, regardless of size or route palatable to this community.

You have repeatedly ignored the community's request for a minor correction of the light reconfiguration at the W-bound lane of the SE 82nd Ave./Sunnyside Rd. intersection making 2 left-turn lanes, rather than one. If the purpose is indeed to move traffic East to West, this would go a long way to make that smoother.

The unrecoverable loss or “mitigation” of the 3-Creeks area as one of the last natural habitats/old oak stands in the urbanized portion of Clackamas County, a legacy to future generations, would be a “legally” criminal act on your part.

We have all witnessed the stripping of Mt. Scott over recent years and the loss of large, natural parcels near our homes and businesses. We have seen the effects of more people in the area, speeding past our schools, through our neighborhoods.

More of the same is neither desired nor necessary. Please call a halt to the Sunnybrook Extension now without further cost and more discontent within our area.
